This park is specifically dedicated to horticultural plantings with winter interest, giving visitors a beautiful, idyllic trek during a time when many people don't look to the woods, fields or streams as places of color on a winter morning. Join other SLAA members on Sunday, March 8th, at 10:00 am, rain, flurries or sunshine—so come dressed for the weather! Bowman's Hill Wildflower Preserve is located on 1635 River Road (PA Rt. 32), New Hope, PA, approximately 2.5 miles south of New Hope. The group will meet at 10 am and enjoy a walk through the beautiful trails of the preserve.
