GDVI Has Initiated the New "Inspirational Story Line"

First, there was the GDVI Inspiration Line, the long-standing call-up telephone service offering brief recorded messages shared by members of the SLAA program worldwide since 1989.

Then in 2017, those involved with the Inspiration Line established Intergroup's second ongoing inspirational activity—the Inspirational Texting Service, an uplifting daily text message sent automatically to member's mobile phones.

Now comes the third inspirational service provided by Intergroup — the Inspirational Story Line.

The Inspirational Story Line is based on the concept of the Inspiration Line, except it offers a longer message, 15-20 minutes in length, designed for the speaker to share his or her story or delve more deeply into a particular topic. The process also allows the caller to leave 5 minutes of feedback.

Each Inspirational Story Line message will be introduced on Sunday night and run for the entire week. One reason for this expanded message service is to provide basic program style material for those meetings located in more remote areas to have a story or discussion topic available to facilitate a meeting. Another is to provide those in times of struggle to hear a personal story and have the platform to give back a substantial response.

Mark A., who along with Michael S. and others on what is now being termed the Inspirational Team initiated the Story Line, pointed out that the above has already happened several times at this early date.

This program has been operating for several months, and GDVI votes on permanently funding the Inspirational Story Line in March 2018.

The Inspirational Team Reports

Inspiration Line Report

In December 2017, the I-Line received 4,648 calls for a daily average of 149 calls. The total call count on Dec. 31 was 254, 837.

Since 2008 The I-Line has logged nearly 1.2 million inbound minutes or over 19,600 hours.

This month 2 new calls came in from Spain and 2 from Russia.

The I-Text Service has 531 subscribers to their daily inspirational message
